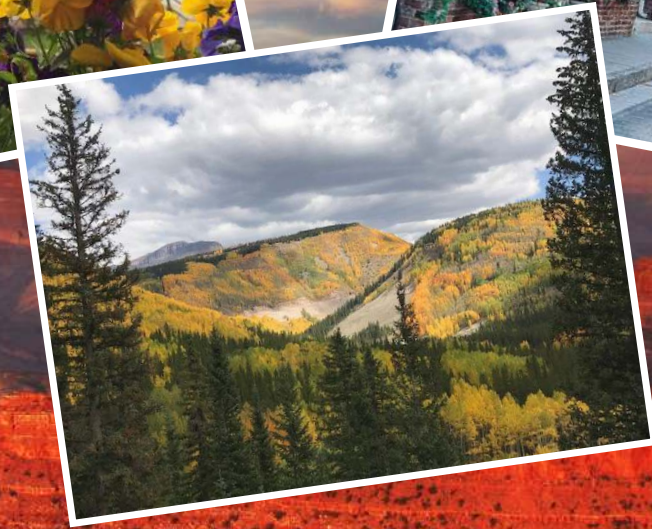

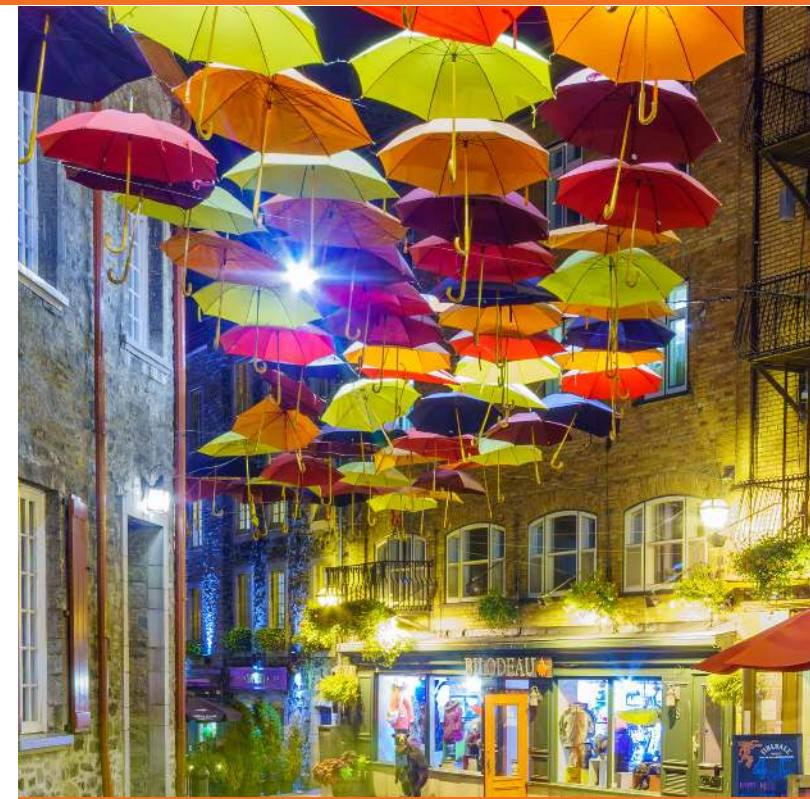

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

Where do tours depart from?

Unless otherwise indicated, motorcoach tours depart from the Daniel’s Discovery Tours office located at the ACE Country Living Complex, 4336 Cornelia Highway, Lula, Georgia 30554. We are just north of Gainesville, Georgia on GA 365 between Mile Marker 31 and 32. If you don’t live near our departure location in Lula, we make it easy for you to join one of our tours with our Pre-Night offer. We will make a reservation for you to stay at a hotel near our office (subject to hotel availability) the night before a tour and you pay only \$50 per room, we pay the rest. We have a large parking lot at our facility where you can park your vehicle for the duration of your trip. The parking lot is locked each evening.

What is included in my tour price?

For Motorcoach Tours printed in this catalog - Motorcoach transportation, hotel accommodations, baggage handling, listed attractions, meals listed as “included”, and a gratuity for the motorcoach driver are included. A Daniel’s Tour Manager will accompany your tour to oversee and implement the tour plan. A gratuity to your Tour Manager is not included and is at your discretion. Each traveler, including those traveling at the “single” rate, are entitled to ONE seat on the motorcoach. Single travelers can expect to have a seat mate. The “Double” price is per person, assuming 2 people share a room. The “Single” price includes a private room for one person. “Triple” and “Quad” pricing is available on limited tours, call for pricing. Those traveling at the Triple or Quad rate should expect 2 beds in a room. Roll-away beds are not available at many hotel properties. We make every effort to accommodate room configuration requests, but requests are based on availability at the properties we use. Deposits are due within 10 days of making a reservation in order to confirm that reservation. We accept all major credit cards and personal checks. Full payment for Day Trips is due at the time of reservation. Fly/Drive Tours, tours offered in affiliation with third parties and cruises have different payment terms than a Daniel’s Discovery Tour motorcoach tour, call us about those details. Tour inclusions listed in this catalog can change without notice due to situations beyond our control; we reserve the right to replace inclusions of similar value if this occurs. The motorcoach tours in this catalog are designed with senior adults in mind (Children must be over the age of 12 to participate in these catalog tours).

What if I have to cancel?

For multi-day DDT motorcoach tours, deposits are refundable up to 45 days prior to departure. Cancellations between 31-45 days receive a refund less the deposit. No refunds for cancellations within 30 days of departure unless Cancellation Insurance has been purchased through DDT, which costs an additional fee. DDT will reimburse trip payments if the trip is cancelled due to sickness, injury or death of the Insured, a close Family Member or the Traveling Companion staying in the same room as the Insured. Sickness or injury must be of a disabling nature as to reasonably cause a trip to be cancelled. A Doctor may be required to sign a Physician’s Statement for cancellations due to illness. For trips that are interrupted due to the unforeseen events as described above, reimbursement for the unused portion of the Insured’s trip will be made. There is no reimbursement for expenses incurred by the traveler as a result of trip interruption. Trip Cancellation Insurance does not include a Medical Expense Benefit. If traveling outside of the U.S., check your personal insurance policy for coverage of medical services incurred outside of the U.S. An additional policy that includes a Medical Expense Benefit can be purchased separately. Contact our office for details. The fee paid for the Trip Cancellation Insurance is due at the time of final payment and is non-refundable. Tours offered in conjunction with third-party providers offer separate insurance policies, ask us about those policies. No refunds are given on Day Trips.

Do you own your Motorcoaches?

Daniel’s Discovery Tours does not own motorcoaches. At one time, our parent company (Daniel’s Charters) owned motorcoaches, but those coaches were sold to another Motorcoach Company (Academy Bus Company) in 2018. Daniel’s Discovery Tours has NOT been sold. We remain an independent Tour Operator with the same owner since 2007. Our company plans the packaged motorcoach tours in this catalog. The motorcoaches we use on our tours are reserved through a separate motorcoach company, and drivers are employees of that motorcoach company. Tour Managers are provided by Daniel’s Discovery Tours.

Is there a lot of walking involved on this tour?

A person planning to travel by motorcoach should be in reasonably good health and be able to walk and move about without assistance. Persons requiring any form of assistance should be accompanied by someone capable and responsible for providing such assistance. Moderate walking can be expected to reach attractions or restaurants on most tours. DDT and its staff are unable to provide designated individual assistance to travelers with special needs for walking or other routine activities. Notify us of any disability requiring special attention such as any dietary restrictions, handicapped accessible room needs, or if accommodations are required on the coach for assistive devices (such as wheelchairs or scooters) at least **2 weeks prior to the tour date**. We will make every effort to accommodate assistive devices as space on the motorcoach allows. We will extend requests to third-party providers to accommodate special needs but we cannot guarantee their compliance. Some tours require extensive walking and climbing stairs due to the nature of the area being toured. Contact us if you are concerned about the amount of walking on a tour and we will provide more details.

Proper I.D.

Some tours and/or venues require personal I.D. Travelers should carry proper I.D. **at all times** when traveling. Passports are required for travel outside of the U.S. Obtaining a valid Passport is the responsibility of the traveler. Tours will not deviate due to a travelers invalid or improper Passport or required I.D. When you travel outside of the U.S., such as in Canada, we recommend you use your credit/debit card for purchases. Let your bank know you are traveling in Canada to prevent an unnecessary Fraud Alert on your account if you use your card out of the country.

Seat Rotation on the Motorcoach

In order to be fair to every traveler, we ask everyone to rotate seats during the tour. We do not assign seats, we ask that you select a different seat at the beginning of each day so everyone has a chance to sit somewhere different. You may choose to opt out of the rotation by selecting a seat toward the back of the coach. The front seat behind the driver is reserved for the Tour Manager. The front seat on the passenger side is reserved for the “Segment VIP”. Travelers are selected by lottery each segment to be the VIP. Each traveler, including those traveling at the “single” rate, are entitled to only ONE seat on the motorcoach. Single travelers can expect to have a seat mate, and those traveling with a companion should sit with their companion as a seat mate on the motorcoach.

SINCE WE TRAVEL IN MANY DIFFERENT STATES THAT HAVE VARYING LAWS, POSSESSION OF WEAPONS OF ANY TYPE ARE NOT PERMITTED ON A DANIEL’S DISCOVERY TOUR. FIREARMS, EXPLOSIVES, FIREWORKS, AND ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN BAGGAGE OR ON THE TRAVELER
