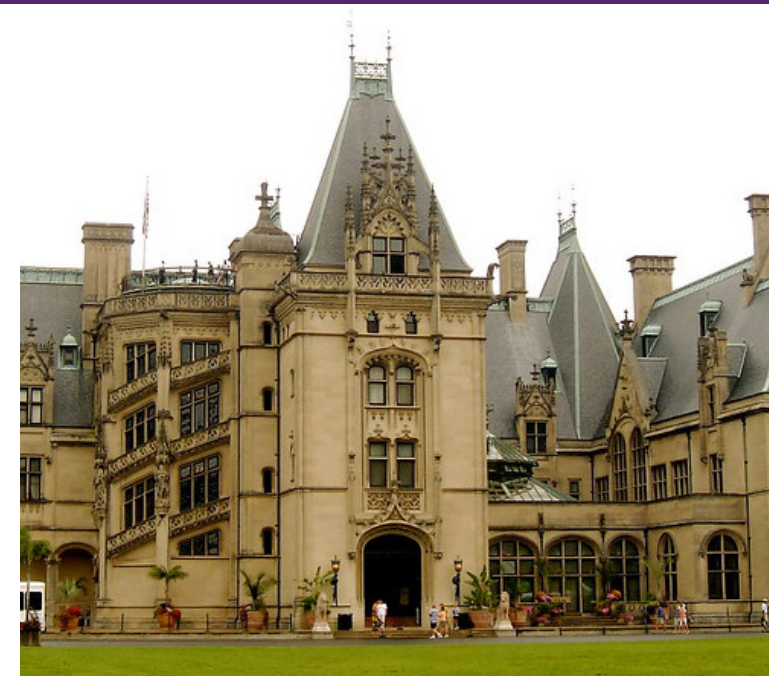

We visit many Amish businesses including a bakery and a bulk foods market on a "Brown Bag" Tour where you receive free "goodies" to fill up your shopping bag. One of the most unique opportunities on this tour is a visit to a one-room Amish school where you get to talk with the Amish teacher, ask questions and visit with the Amish children. Drive through the countryside and learn about farming techniques and other innovative businesses of the Indiana Amish such as a camel dairy (yes, we said camel dairy!) and a casket and coffin maker. See the horse and buggies "clip clop" all over downtown Shipshewana as you enjoy some free time to explore. Where do tours depart from?

Unless otherwise indicated, motorcoach tours depart from the Daniel's Discovery Tours office located at the ACE Country Living Complex, 4336 Cornelia Highway, Lula, Georgia 30554 located 10 miles north of Gainesville, Georgia on Hwy 365 between Mile Marker 31 and 32. We have a large parking lot at our facility where you can park your vehicle for the duration of your trip. The parking lot is locked each evening.

What is included in my tour price?

For Motorcoach Tours printed in this catalog - Motorcoach transportation, hotel accommodations, baggage handling, listed attractions, meals listed as "included", and a gratuity for the motorcoach driver are included. A Daniel's Tour Manager will accompany your tour to oversee and implement the tour plan. A gratuity to your Tour Manager is not included and is at your discretion. Each traveler, including those traveling at the "single" rate, is entitled to ONE seat on the motorcoach. Single travelers can expect to have a seat mate. The "Double" price is per person, assuming 2 people share a room. The "Single" price includes a private room for one person. "Triple" and "Quad" pricing is available on limited tours, call for pricing. We make every effort to accommodate room configuration requests, but requests are based on availability at the properties we use. Deposits are due within 10 days of making a reservation and can be made by check, cash or credit card. Final Payment is due 45 days prior to the trip departure date and is due by check or cash. Final payments made by credit card will be accessed a credit card convenience fee. Fly/Drive Tours, tours offered in affiliation with third parties and cruises have different payment terms than a Daniel's Discovery Tour motorcoach tour, call us about those details. Tour inclusions listed in this catalog can change without notice due to situations beyond our control; we reserve the right to replace inclusions of similar value if this occurs. The motorcoach tours in this catalog are designed with senior adults in mind, children must be over the age of 13 to participate in these catalog tours.

What if I have to cancel?

For multi-day DDT motorcoach tours, deposits are refundable up to 45 days prior to departure. Cancellations between 31-45 days receive a refund less the deposit. No refunds for cancellations within 30 days of departure. Cancellation Assurance can be purchased for an additional fee and guarantees the traveler will receive reimbursement of trip payments for cancellations due to sickness, injury or death of the traveler, a close family member or the traveling companion staying in the same room. Sickness or injury must be of a disabling nature as to reasonably cause a trip to be cancelled. A Doctor may be required to sign a statement for cancellations due to illness. For trips that are interrupted due to the unforeseen events as described above, reimbursement for the unused portion of the trip will be made. There is no reimbursement for expenses incurred by the traveler as a result of trip interruption. There is no Medical Expense Benefit. If traveling outside of the U.S., check your personal health insurance policy for coverage of medical services incurred outside of the U.S. A Trip Cancellation Insurance policy that includes a Medical Expense Benefit can be purchased separately. Do you own the Motorcoaches you use?

Daniel's Discovery Tours does not own motorcoaches. At one time, our parent company - Daniel's Charters & Tours, LLC - owned motorcoaches, but those coaches were sold. Daniel's Discovery Tours has NOT been sold. We remain an independent Tour Operator with the same owner since 2007. Our company plans the packaged motorcoach tours in this catalog. The motorcoaches we use on our tours are reserved through an unaffiliated motorcoach company, and drivers are employees of that motorcoach company. Tour Managers are provided by Daniel's Discovery Tours.

Is there a lot of walking involved on this tour?

A person planning to travel by motorcoach should be in reasonably good health in order to navigate the itinerary and fully enjoy the tour. Moderate walking can be expected to reach attractions or restaurants on most tours. Travelers requiring any form of assistance should be accompanied by someone capable and responsible for providing such assistance. While we are committed to providing accommodations to all of our travelers, DDT and its staff are unable to provide designated individual assistance to travelers with special needs for walking or other routine activities. Notify us of any dietary restrictions, disability requiring special accommodations, handicapped accessible room needs, or if accommodations are required on the coach for assistive devices (such as wheelchairs or scooters) at least 2 weeks prior to the tour date. We will make every effort to accommodate assistive devices as space on the motorcoach allows. We will extend requests to third-party providers to accommodate special needs but we cannot guarantee their compliance. Some tours require extensive walking and climbing stairs due to the nature of the area being toured. Contact us if you are concerned about the amount of walking on a tour and we will provide more details.

Proper I.D.

Travelers should carry proper I.D. at all times when traveling. Passports are required for travel outside of the U.S. Obtaining a valid Passport is the responsibility of the traveler. Tours will not deviate due to a travelers invalid or improper Passport or required I.D.
