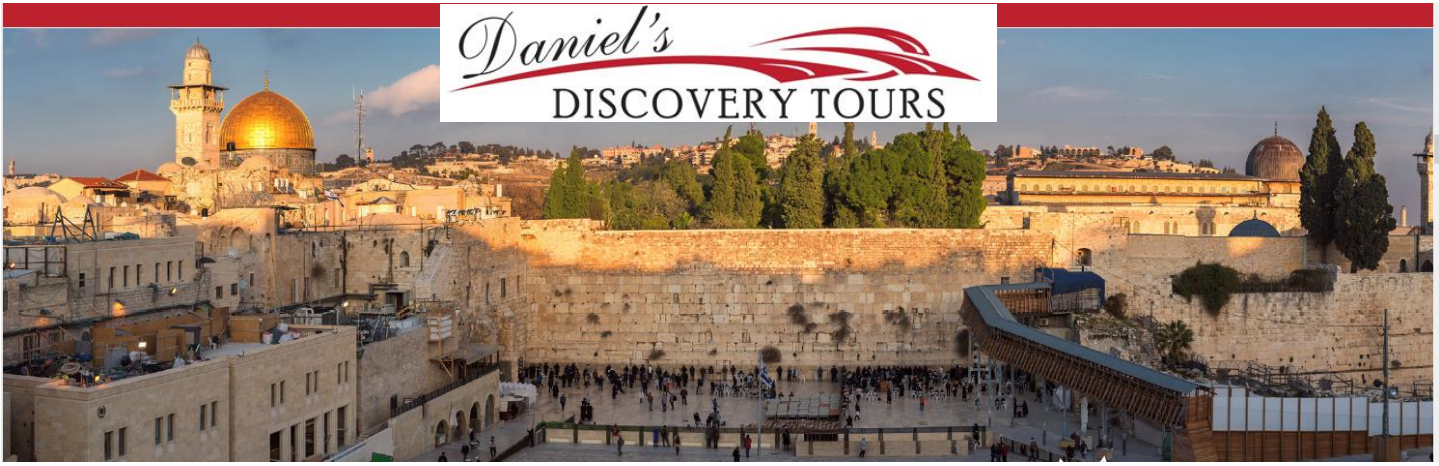

A Journey of Faith to Israel

(1) Tuesday March - 5 Depart USA for Tel Aviv

Your pilgrimage begins as you join Daniel's Guides Stan and Adrienne Lovell along with your fellow Daniel's travelers from Lula, GA to the Atlanta airport for your flight from the USA to Tel Aviv.

(2) Wednesday March 6 - Tiberius Arrive in Tel Aviv and Overnight in Tiberius.

(3) Thursday March 7 - Sea of Galilee / Capernaum / Mt. of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Peter's Primacy / Fish Lunch / Magdala / Jordan River

Baptismal Site - Worship as you sail across the Sea of Galilee. Visit Capernaum, center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee, and visit the synagogue built on the site where Jesus taught (Matthew 4:13, 23). On the Mount of Beatitudes, contemplate the "Sermon on the Mount" (Matthew 5-7). Explore the Church of the Fish and the Loaves at Tabgha, traditional site of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10-17). See the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter professed his devotion three times to the risen Christ (John 21). In Magdala, once home to Mary Magdalene, visit a recently discovered first-century synagogue. Recall Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist at the Jordan River, you can choose to be baptized in the river.

(4) Friday March 8 - Cana / Nazareth / Tel Megiddo / Caesarea Maritima - Visit the Franciscan Wedding Chapel in Cana, site of Jesus' first miracle, before continuing to Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23). Look out over Tel Megiddo (Armageddon) to view one of the most important archaeological sites in Israel. Today's last stop is Caesarea, a center of the early Christians where an angel visited Cornelius, the first Gentile believer (Acts 10), and where Paul was imprisoned for two years before appealing to Caesar.

(5) Saturday March 9 - Jerusalem Beth Shean / Jordan Valley / Jericho / Qumran / Overview Look of Jerusalem / Jerusalem - Visit Bet Shean, a city continuously inhabited for over 5,000 years. The uncovered ruins date back to the Greek / Roman city that was part of the Decapolis of Jesus' day. See colonnaded streets with marble sidewalks, Roman public baths, and a theater. As you stop in Jericho to view the ruins of the city conquered by Joshua (Joshua 6:1, 2, 20), in the distance you can also see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matthew 4:1-11). Continue to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947.

(6) Sunday March 10 - Bethlehem / Yad Vashem. In Bethlehem, visit the cave revered as Jesus' birthplace and see the Church of the Nativity constructed over the site (Matthew 1:18-25). Gaze out over Shepherds' Field before returning to Jerusalem. Explore the poignant exhibits of Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial.

(7) Monday March 11 - Mt. of Olives / Palm Sunday Road / Garden of Gethsemane / Caiaphas' House / Upper Room / City of David / Hezekiah's Tunnel / Pool of Siloam - Visit the Mount of Olives, where Jesus ascended into heaven (Acts 1:9-12). Walk the Palm Sunday Road and pray in the Garden of Gethsemane and envision the scenes of the night before Jesus' crucifixion (Matthew 26:36 - 44). Continue to Mount Zion to visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas, where Jesus was questioned the night of His betrayal (Matthew 26:57). Meditate on the events of the Last Supper as you visit the traditional location of the Upper Room (Mark 14:12-26). After lunch, wander through the excavations of the City of David. Explore Hezekiah's Tunnel, an amazing engineering feat that was dug from either end and met in the middle! Visit the Pool of Siloam, recently uncovered at the foot of the city.

(8) Tuesday March 12 - Masada / Dead Sea - Visit Masada and the Dead Sea. Ascend by cable car to Masada, Herod's legendary mountaintop fortress which became the last desperate stronghold of the Jewish Zealots against the Romans. You can still look down on the remains of the Roman camps and the siege ramp below. You will have an opportunity to float in the salt and mineral-laden waters of the Dead Sea if you like.

(9) Wednesday March 13 - Teaching Steps / Western Wall / Pool of Bethesda - Church of St. Anne / Antonia Fortress / Via Dolorosa / Church of the Holy Sepulchre / Garden Tomb / Gordon's Calvary.

Explore ancient Jerusalem at the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. View the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle (John 5:1-18). Sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne and experience its rich acoustics. Visit Herod's Antonia Fortress, where Jesus appeared before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1) and follow in Christ's steps on the Via Dolorosa ("the Way of the Cross"). At the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, take time to reflect on His sacrificial love. Visit the Garden Tomb for a time of reflection and communion. Transfer to Airport for Late Night flight to USA.

10) Thursday March 14 - Flight Tel Aviv to Atlanta.
