Enjoy extraordinary landscapes on this Journey through the Clouds onboard Rocky Mountaineer's Gold Leaf Glass Dome Train. This tour takes you through some of the most untouched, breathtaking natural beauty on the planet from Vancouver, Kamloops, Jasper, Banff, Lake Louise, and Calgary. Join your Daniel's Guide in Lula, GA to start your Rocky Mountaineer adventure. Transfer to the Atlanta airport for your flight to Vancouver International Airport. Start your tour by exploring the Inner Harbour of downtown Victoria, and world-renowned Butchart Gardens. Travel by train from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior - see the steep slopes and rock sheds along the **Thompson River** and the rushing waters of **Hell's Gate** in the **Fraser** Canyon. Journey by train into the province of Alberta including Mount Robson, at 12,972 feet, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. The rails pass Pyramid Falls, then climb over the Yellowhead Pass to Jasper National Park and the resort town of Jasper. Enjoy a motorcoach sightseeing tour along the Icefields Parkway, one of the world's most scenic highways – highlights are the **Columbia Icefield**, an Ice Explorer ride on the **Athabasca Glacier**, and a visit to the Glacier Skywalk. Explore Banff National Park by motorcoach. Well known for iconic turquoise waters, Lake Louise offers a jaw dropping view of towering peaks rising from the famous glacier fed lake. Enjoy a motorcoach tour exploring the many places of interest around Banff, including Banff Gondola, Bow Falls, Surprise Corner, and the Hoodoos. Make your way by motorcoach to Calgary for an overnight stay before your return flight **FLY-OUT TOUR / PASSPORT REQUIRED** to Georgia.

Rocky Mountaineer Canadian Rockies May 10 – 18, 2026, 9 Days/8 Nights

Day 1: May 10, 2026

Meet your Daniel's Guide at the Daniel's Tour Depot in Lula, GA for our motorcoach transfer to Atlanta to catch our flight. Travelers may choose to meet the group at the airport if more convenient. We arrive in Vancouver, BC this evening. *Accommodations: Fairmont Waterfront Hotel Vancouver* (2 Nights)



Day 2: May 11, 2026



Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel before we board a motorcoach for a full day of touring by land and sea! We embark on a 90 minute Ferry ride through the Gulf Islands (watch for marine life!) to Vancouver Island and explore the capital of British Columbia, Victoria - considered one of the world's most beautiful cities! Visit the world-renowned Butchart Gardens, which have been in bloom for over 100 years! The 55 acres of gardens are stunning with an abundance of fragrance and color! Enjoy free time to explore on your own before we return to Vancouver and the *Fairmont Waterfront Hotel* this evening. (B)

Day 3: May 12, 2026

Today, depart the Pacific NW coastal city of Vancouver via Rocky Mountaineer Gold Leaf Dome Train into the heart of British Columbia's interior, Kamloops. You will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the BC Interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Travel along the shores of Kamloops Lake into Kamloops. Motorcoach transfer to your accommodations: *Hotel tba* (1 Night). (B & L Onboard Train)



Day 4: May 13, 2026



Early this morning, you will be transferred by motorcoach to the train station where your train journey continues north and east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, Pyramid Falls, and the crystal-clear Moose Lake. *Accommodations: Forest Park Hotel* (2 Nights) (B & L Onboard)

Day 5: May 14, 2026

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel before boarding a motorcoach for a sightseeing tour of Jasper. Highlights include Pyramid and Patricia Lakes, Maligne Canyon and the Athabasca viewpoint. This afternoon, we explore inside Jasper National Park and take in the beautiful scenery of the Maligne Valley with stops at the glacial fed Medicine Lake and Maligne Canyon, perhaps you'll also catch a glimpse of the wildlife that calls this region home. Return to *Forest Park Hotel*. (B,D)



Day 6: May 15, 2026



After breakfast, we board a motorcoach for a full-day sightseeing tour along the Icefields Parkway, one of the world's most scenic highways. The highlight today is a visit to the Columbia Icefield and an Ice Explorer ride on the Athabasca Glacier. Take a ride on a giant six-wheel drive Ice Explorer vehicle while your guide explains the history of this ancient glacier before you make a stop to walk on the glacier! You can also take a walk on the Glacier Skywalk. Consisting of a 400 metre (1,640 feet) interpretive boardwalk and a glassfloored observation platform extending 30 metres (98 feet) out over the Sunwapta Valley, Glacier Skywalk takes spectacular scenery and a rare view

of nature to unbelievable heights. Arrive into the beautiful city of Banff in Alberta, Canada this evening. *Hotel: Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel* (2 Nights). (B,L)

Day 7: May 16, 2026

We depart after breakfast by motorcoach to tour through Banff National Park - Canada's first national park featuring Rocky Mountain peaks, turquoise glacial lakes, and abundant wildlife. On this sightseeing tour you will visit the "Jewel of the Canadian Rockies", Lake Louise, a UNESCO World Heritage Site because of its priceless natural beauty. Walk along the shoreline at Lake Louise, see the Victoria Glacier and the famous Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise Hotel. Learn about the natural forces that have shaped the appearance of the lakes and streams found in this area of the Rocky Mountains. Other highlights today include Yoho National Park, the Spiral Tunnels,



Emerald Lake, Natural Bridge and Takakkaw Falls. Lunch today is included. Return to downtown Banff for free time late this afternoon for dinner on your own and exploring the resort town full of great restaurants and souvenir shops. Enjoy night 2 at the fabulous *Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel*. (B,L)

Day 8: May 17, 2026

After breakfast, we depart the hotel by motorcoach. See more sights in Banff National Park including Mt. Rundle, Mt. Cascade and Bow Falls as we make our way to the Banff Gondola. Take the spectacular eight-minute gondola ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain for 360-degree views of the Banff townsite and its surrounding mountains. Enjoy the beautiful drive as we make our way to Calgary. *Hotel: Hyatt Regency Hotel.* (B)



Day 9: May 18, 2026

Transfer to the Calgary Airport today for our return flight to Atlanta with memories of an unforgettable tour through the Canadian Rockies. (B)
