

Discover Real Alaska by Rail

- **Day 1:** Transport from the Daniel's Tour Depot in Lula, GA by motorcoach to Atlanta Int Airport for our morning flight to Anchorage where our Alaska Adventure begins.
- **Day 2:** Enjoy sightseeing in Anchorage today with a visit to the Alaska Heritage Center and exploring with lunch on your own downtown. Dinner is included with your travel companions this evening. (B,D)
- Day 3: This morning, enjoy breakfast in the dining car aboard the ALASKA RAIL COASTAL CLASSIC Goldstar Service Dome Train from Anchorage for a late morning arrival into Seward, Alaska where you will discover "Real Alaska" today as we tour Seward. Visit Iditarod Champion Mitch Seavey's racing kennel, meet the puppies and go for a wilderness dog sled ride; take a short walk along a nature trail to Exit Glacier, see the salmon as they swim upstream to spawn. Dinner is included this evening at the Lodge in Seward. (B,L,D)
- **Day 4:** Enjoy a leisurely morning at the Lodge before we embark on an exciting cruise on Resurrection Bay to explore the world of whales, wildlife, and glaciers. We return to the Lodge for an included dinner with another overnight stay in Seward. (B,L,D)
- Day 5: This morning we travel by motorcoach from Seward to Whittier for an afternoon cruise on the calm waters of Prince William Sound. This experience is unforgettable as we set sail along Esther Passage to seek out 26 majestic alpine and tidewater glaciers in College Fjord. Travel in luxurious comfort aboard the Klondike Express, the fastest catamaran in Alaska. Watch for otters, seals, mountain goats and Steller sea lions narration provided by a U.S. Forest Service Ranger. Return to overnight in Anchorage via the GLACIER DISCOVERY TRAIN this evening (B,L)
- Day 6: We depart Anchorage this morning aboard Alaska Rail's premier train ride the DENALI STAR Glass Dome Train. Goldstar Service includes breakfast and lunch in the dining car. Enjoy spectacular scenery along this route, be on the lookout for Moose! The train arrives later this afternoon at Denali, and we make our way to our Denali Lodge. Enjoy a 2-night stay near Denali National Park. You will be entertained this evening at a fun Musical Dinner Theater. (B,L,D)
- Day 7: Denali National Park Tour Focusing on the rich natu-

ral and cultural history of the park, we tour into Denali National Park to the Primrose Overlook. Several interpretive stops enhance the experience with on & off bus experiences. Beginning with a stop at the Denali Bus Depot, learn about the creation of the Denali Park Road with the film "Across Time and Tundra." Next, visit the historical Savage Cabin to learn how the cabin was once used, and how it continues to be used today. Finally, a stop at Primrose Ridge to experience a memorable Alaska Native presentation that will enlighten you with how the land has been used for nearly 10,000 years! Your driver/naturalist will provide an overview of the landscape, geology, and history of Denali National Park and Preserve aboard the Denali Natural History Tour. Be on the lookout for wildlife in the park! (B)

- **Day 8:** We depart Denali today and make the scenic motor-coach drive to Fairbanks with stops along the way to visit the highlights of the Alaska landscape. We settle in for a 2-night stay in downtown Fairbanks overlooking the Chena River. Explore historic downtown Fairbanks with dinner on your own. (B)
- Day 9: We explore Fairbanks today! Cruise the Chena River aboard the Riverboat Discovery into the heart of Alaska. Get immersed in frontier living first-hand with a guided walking tour of an Athabascan village; see an Alaskan bush pilot takeoff and land right next to the Riverboat; Enjoy an included lunch at Steamboat Landing and visit the great Gift Shop! Strike it rich in the gold fields of Alaska at Gold Dredge 8 and Mining Museum. Your two-hour tour will take you into the heart of the gold fields of the Tanana Valley where you will feel the history come alive. Alaskan miners will show you how to pan for gold, and you will receive your own poke filled with pay dirt to try your luck! Return to the Fairbanks hotel this evening. (B,L)
- **Day 10:** We will visit North Pole, Alaska today along with the delightful Christmas shop where every day is a holiday. Our flight departs Fairbanks this afternoon. (B)
- **Day 11:** Our return flight into Atlanta arrives this morning. We return to Lula, GA by motorcoach with unforgettable memories of this trip of a lifetime. (B)
