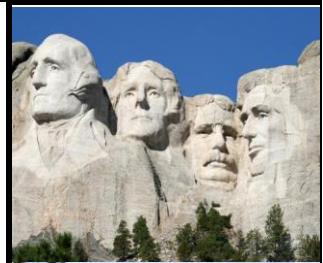

July 27 - August 9, 2026

DAY ONE - Travel to Marion, IL

Westward we go! We are on a motorcoach journey of a lifetime. Our first day takes us through Tennessee and Kentucky to our overnight stop near Marion, IL. (DI)

DAY TWO - Travel to St. Louis and Kansas City

Today we enter the West as did thousands of early settlers, by way of St. Louis, MO where you will see the tallest man-made monument in the Western Hemisphere - the 630 foot Gateway Arch, and visit the Gateway Arch Museum. We make our way to Kansas City for an overnight stay. (B, DI)

DAY THREE - Travel to Omaha, NE & Sioux Falls, SD

Explore historic Omaha and enjoy lunch on your own at the lively Old Market. We continue to follow the Missouri River as we travel to South Dakota to Sioux Falls. See the Big Sioux River as 7,400 gallons of water drop 100 feet over the course of the Falls in the heart of downtown Sioux Falls. (B)

DAY FOUR - Travel to Mitchell SD & the Corn Palace, Wall Drug & Badlands National Park

- This morning we travel along the prairie with a stop to visit the famous Corn Palace in Mitchell, SD. We can only imagine how difficult it was for the early settlers to make this trip without a modern and comfortable motorcoach. In recent years, travelers have found relief by stopping at Wall Drug Store for a FREE drink of water. We will make that stop for our FREE drink. We travel through Badlands National Park today, which provides a scenic wonderland of irregular ravines, fantastic ridges and variegated color alternation with grayish-white sediment. We overnight the next two nights in Rapid City, SD. (B, D)

DAY FIVE - Tour Black Hills of South Dakota

Mount Rushmore symbolizes the ideals of freedom, democracy and the American dream in the four 60-foot granite faces. This mountain carving of Presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln draws over three million visitors a year, including us today. Visit beautiful Custer State Park and learn about their permanent Bison Herd. Spend some time at the Crazy Horse Memorial. It is more than just a monument; it is a living symbol of the great chief of the Sioux Nation. Enjoy a Chuckwagon style dinner with entertainment tonight and explore some of the set buildings from the movie, *Dances with Wolves*. (B,D)

DAY SIX - Travel to Cody WY

Today we travel across the beautiful Big Horn Mountains, through the Shoshone National Forest and arrive into Cody, WY for a visit to the Buffalo Bill Museum. Cody is the RODEO capitol of the world, so you can attend the Cody Rodeo after an included dinner at the famous Irma Hotel! (B,D)

DAY SEVEN - Travel to Yellowstone National Park

This morning we drive along the scenic Buffalo Bill Hwy on our way to Yellowstone, established in 1872 as the world's first national park. We begin exploring the highlights of this "national treasure" today from geysers to wildlife, the Yellowstone experience is second to none! Enjoy 2 nights in West Yellowstone, MT. You will love exploring this quaint western town in your free time. (B,L)

DAY EIGHT - Yellowstone NP & Old Faithful

Today, we return to Yellowstone National Park for more exploring, including the famous Old Faithful! Learn about the massive volcanic Caldera, gushing geysers & deep can-

yons. See the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, the historic Old Faithful Inn & look for bears, bison, elk, wolves and antelope along the way. Enjoy free time in West Yellowstone, MT this evening. (B,L)

DAY NINE - Great Salt Lake, Utah

This morning we drive through Idaho as we make our way to Utah for a visit to the shores of the Great Salt Lake on Antelope Island - the largest island in the lake. View wildlife and learn about the mysterious wonder of the Great Salt Lake. Overnight south of Salt Lake City. (B)

DAY TEN - Moab & Arches National Park

The landscape of the Southwest is red rocks, sage brush, and an undeveloped landscape of interesting formations. The lively town of Moab stands out as the gateway to endless outdoor adventure and to Arches National Park where we drive through the largest concentration of natural sandstone arches on earth. We enter Colorado in the afternoon with an overnight stay in Grand Junction. (B)

DAY ELEVEN - Rocky Mountains of Colorado

Visit the upscale mountain resort town of Vail today and explore the European-style village. Our motorcoach takes us along the steep and winding turns along scenic Vail Pass as we reach the elevation of 10,662 feet. We overnight near Denver - the mile high city. (B, DI)

DAY TWELVE - Travel to Topeka, KS

We make our way back East today as we travel through Kansas and overnight near Topeka. (B,D)

DAY THIRTEEN - Travel to Paducah KY

We travel to Paducah, KY today for an overnight stay. (B,DI)

DAY FOURTEEN - Return to North Georgia

We return home today with wonderful memories of our tour of the Great National Parks of the Northwest & Southwest! (B)
